



**ADMISSION EVALUATION CRITERIA**  
VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY PROFESSIONAL PROGRAM  
NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY  
FARGO, NORTH DAKOTA

Applications for admission to the Veterinary Technology Professional Program at North Dakota State University will be accepted from candidates that have **completed at least 12 credits of NDSU courses and having earned a C or better in VETS125 Animal Restraint and VETS115 Medical Terminology.**

The applications will be evaluated on a 100-point scale according to four criteria: academic performance, experience with the veterinary profession, a reference from a veterinary technician or veterinarian, and general references. Maximum points will be assigned as follows:

<b>Academic performance</b>	60 points	cumulative NDSU GPA x 15 (for example, if you have an NDSU GPA of 3.0 you will be assigned 45 points out of the maximum of 60 points) **
<b>Experience with the veterinary profession</b>	20 points	one point for each 2 hours of veterinary clinic observation up to 20 points (for example, if you observe in a veterinary clinic for 32 hours you will be assigned 16 points out of the maximum 20 points)
<b>Reference from a veterinary technician or veterinarian</b>	10 points	preferably from a veterinary clinic where observation is done
<b>General references</b>	10 points	2 references @ 5 points each
<b>Maximum possible points</b>	<b>100 points</b>
